


Meals

- **Monday through Friday**

Three meals are provided daily from Monday to Friday: breakfast, lunch and dinner. All meals are served in an all-you-can-eat buffet style. A typical buffet includes a selection of salads, main courses, desserts, fruit and drinks.

- **Saturday and Sunday**

Weekends are made for sleeping in! Breakfast and lunch are combined into a single meal – our copious, popular brunch buffet. In the evening, a hearty dinner awaits students in the cafeteria after they return from the day's excursions and activities.

- **BBQs**

For a change of pace, our chefs occasionally organise garden barbecues with a large choice of grilled meats and sausages, as well as a selection of healthy salads, finished off with a delicious dessert buffet and fresh fruit.

Accommodation

Participants are housed in standard or deluxe, single or double rooms. The standard double room is included in the course fee, or alternatively a deluxe room is available at an additional price (please see the admissions form). All deluxe and standard rooms have their own bathroom.


